

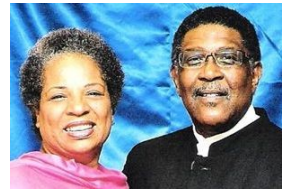

Our purpose for The Stones' House Project is providing a Christian and loving environment where ex-offenders are offered affordable transitional housing. LSI's goal is to impact 100 men in three years.

To help these men achieve a stable living arrangement and prevent their return to prison, LSI will offer job training/apprenticeships, educational programs and mentoring. Help us reach more men by sowing today.

Due to the most recent statistics, The Stones' House Project is for men who are transformed in prison, yet unable to find a place to live and need our support. During Florida's fiscal year 2007-2008, 37,018 inmates completed their sentences and were released back into our communities.

Approximately 32.8 percent of those released inmates are projected to return to prison within three years. This can be reduced to a key factor—having a place to live once released from prison.
