I was in prison and you came to Me."

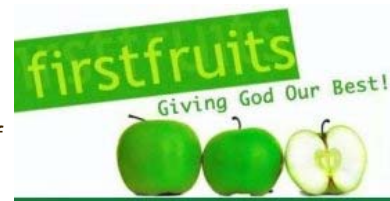
The trick. . .

The Treat. . .

God blesses those who are a blessing to others. Proverbs 3:9 speaks of honoring the Lord with your possessions, especially your first fruits, so your barns and vats will overflow. What this means is practicing good stewardship and implementing proper investment of your time and resources.
