

Services

Children of Value (COVE)

A free after school program that meets four times a week and features academic tutoring, mentorship, group talks, art activities, and education about the benefits of living healthy. Participants receive transportation to LSI, nutritious snacks, and a safe, supervised environment. LSI's staff collaborates with Florida A&M University and Florida State University students, interns, and volunteers to promote a better student achievement in COVE.

Children of Inmates

Partnering with the Service Network for Children of Inmates, LSI provides wrap around and bonding services for children who are impacted by parental incarceration. LSI coordinates quarterly special bonding visits for children and families in correctional institutions in the Big Bend region.

Growing Together

A gardening program, created in partnership with Florida A&M University, that combines family time with healthy nutrition and outdoor exercise.
